Yaesu FT950 The FT 950 is a top notch radio, with DSP, two VFO's, CW keyer w memory's, and built in antenna tuner. Any DX'er or contester would be well set. The radio lists for \$1,800 and is selling for \$1,300 now. I watched two on E Bay go for \$1,100 for the radio alone. This one comes with the matching speaker with audio filters. Asking \$1,000. Records indicate this radio was bought in 2008.


Elections 2011



Recipe of the Month–Pumpkin Rum Pecan Pie



Ingredients

Crust:

1- 9 inch frozen, thawed pie crust, partially baked

1 cup chopped pecans

1/2 cup brown sugar

3 tbsp. butter, room temperature

1/8 tsp. salt

Filling:

1 cup evaporated milk

1 tsp. ground cinnamon

1/2 tsp. salt

1/2 tsp. ground ginger

1/4 tsp. ground cloves

1/4 tsp. grated nutmeg

1 cup canned pumpkin pie filling

2/3 cup brown sugar

2 large eggs

3 tbsp. dark rum

Topping:

1 cup pecan halves

3/4 cup water

1/4 cup honey

3 tbsp. sugar

1 cup vegetable oil

Directions

For Crust:

Stir together the pecans, brown sugar, butter and salt and spread over the bottom of the prepared crust.

For Filling:

Preheat oven to 450 degrees. Stir together the evaporated milk, cinnamon, salt, ginger, cloves and nutmeg in a large bowl. Beat in the pumpkin pie filling, brown sugar, eggs and rum. Spoon the filling into the prepared crust. Place the pie on a sheet pan and bake 10 minutes. Reduce the oven to 350 degrees and bake pie about 35 to 45 minutes until the filling is set. Let pie cool 15 minutes on the sheet pan. Transfer pie to a rack and cool completely.

For Topping:

Combine the pecan halves, water and honey in a medium saucepan over medium high heat. Boil 5 minutes. Drain the pecans and return them to the saucepan. Sprinkle the pecans with sugar and toss to coat. Arrange the pecans on wax paper in a single layer. Place the oil in a separate saucepan and heat to 375 degrees. Fry the pecans in the oil about 2 minutes until lightly browned and the sugar starts to caramelize. Drain pecans on linen kitchen towels. Cool pecans completely until crisp and dry. Arrange the pecan halves over the top of the pie before serving.
